We have an extensive CCTV system in and around school, which provides one level of security, but over half term we will be implementing changes to our external doors that will ensure that the school is locked down during the school day.

The site has always been a very open one and the Governors feel that the time is now right to introduce this system in order to make it a more secure site for all the staff and pupils involved.
