

A total of 8 primary and secondary schools made it to the final and each team created a presentation stand and delivered a 5 minute presentation to a panel of judges in a 'Dragons Den' style pitch. Their idea related to a design for a truck of the future. The 4 pupils involved were Austin Hodges, Joshua Free, Joshua Lowe and Alexander Malinowski. Their presentation was excellent, showing their STEM skills by combining all of the subject areas to create an innovative and interesting modular, driver-less design. The overall winning design will be revealed at Leyland Festival on Saturday 17 June 2017, where it will be made into the 14th truck in the current Truck Trail that can be seen in and around Leyland town centre.
