A burst water main directly outside the school led to all our water being turned off. United Utilities explained the situation to us and there was no prospect of any water on our site by the end of the school day (the water was eventually turned back on around 8:00 p.m.). We contacted parents via text message, ordered the buses and made sure that all pupils could contact a family member if they needed to. The final pupils left the school around 1:15 p.m.

Mobile Phones

Reminder of the change to the Mobile Phone Policy, which came into force on Monday 15 January 2018. From that date any pupil using the mobile phone in school will have the phone removed, the phone will be taken to the School Office from where the pupil can collect it at the end of the day but the punishment for this will now be an automatic Friday Night Detention.
