Jesus' eleven disciples went to a mountain in Galilee, where Jesus had told them to meet him. They saw him and worshiped him, but some of them doubted.



Jesus came to them and said: "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth! Go to the people of all nations and make them my disciples. Baptise them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and teach them to do everything I have told you.

I will be with you always, even until the end of the world."

SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT

In this week's scripture passage we see Jesus talking to his disciples for the last time before he ascended to heaven to be with his Father.

Imagine how the disciples were feeling...they had followed Jesus everywhere for three years, and now they face the scary prospect of being left alone, without him for guidance.


