
The Baptism of the Lord

SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT

Baptism is the way that we are welcomed into the Church.

Through baptism our sins are forgiven and we are committed to God and to trying to live our lives the way that

God wants us to, calls us to.

It is not easy, but in the same way that the Holy Spirit came to Jesus when He was baptised, we are baptised with water and the Holy Spirit. The Spirit is there to help us when we find things difficult and to guide us to make the right choices.

SOMETHING TO TALK ABOUT

Talk to the person next to you and come up with a list of ways in which people can be named, e.g. daughter of Sue, sister or brother of John etc.

Just as we have many ways in which we might be named and identified, Jesus also was identified in many different ways.

Talk to the person next to you again and list as many different ways Jesus is named. Use your previous list to help e.g. Son of Mary.

In this week's Gospel from Matthew, we hear the name that Jesus was given by the voice from heaven after his baptism.

name we are called by our
baptismal name, and each of us are
also named a "CHILD OF GOD".
These names ought to be included
on your list of names for yourself.
*Brother or Sister of Jesus.
*Child of God.
Just as Jesus learned what this
meant in his life through prayer, so
our prayer helps us learn what it
means to be a child of God.
