#### Faraday Challenge – Thursday 7th November 2019

12 Year 8 pupils arrived at Penwortham Girls' High School not really knowing what was in store, other than they needed to solve an engineering problem. A representative of Airbus and IET delivered the session, where they found out they were to create an innovative solution to a humanitarian aid problem e.g. after effects of flood, supplying food and aid to remote areas, providing shelter for those displaced by disaster.

They worked in two teams of 6 to design and make a prototype, to a tight budget, which included an electronic circuit, as well as prepare and deliver a presentation. All the pupils worked fantastically well together, designing two very imaginative solutions and delivering an engaging and exciting talk about their work. Sadly they did not get through to the North final on this occasion but they should be very proud of their hard work and determination. Well done!
