- ✓ Year 7 you have been finding out about Natural Resources

Both of these topics make us think about **how we all use the Earth's valuable resources** and **how it affects people and the environment**. You all know the difference between **renewable and non-renewable resources**.

We all need to think about how we use natural resources. We can:

- <u>Reduce</u> use fewer resources eg by thinking carefully about what we are buying
- <u>Recycle</u> process resources so that they can be used again eg glass, plastic bottles
- <u>Reuse</u> eg donate items to a charity shop or pass items on to someone else

- 2) Create a poster to encourage people to reduce recycle reuse. You need to think about your target audience. It can be a poster for everyone or for young people of your age. ONE page not a number of PowerPoint slides. Save it. We could use it for a display when we get back to school. This is an important issue and we really need to get a clear message across. Words and pictures. Not massive fonts!

- Paint

- Plaster and plasterboard*
- Plastic bottles
- Printer cartridges

- Scrap metal
- Textiles, clothes and shoes
- TV's and monitors
- Tyres
- Wood
