

## Work set for Year 7 and Year 8 for week beginning Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June

- ✓ **Year 7** – you have been finding out about **Natural Resources**
- ✓ **Year 8** – you have been finding out about **Global Warming and Climate Change**

Both of these topics make us think about **how we all use the Earth's valuable resources** and **how it affects people and the environment**. You all know the difference between **renewable and non-renewable resources**.

We all need to think about how we use natural resources. We can:

- ✓ **Reduce** – use fewer resources eg by thinking carefully about what we are buying
- ✓ **Recycle** – process resources so that they can be used again eg glass, plastic bottles
- ✓ **Reuse** – eg donate items to a charity shop or pass items on to someone else

### Your task

- 1) Look at the web links below. There will be plenty more if you need more ideas.
- 2) **Create a poster** to encourage people to **reduce – recycle – reuse**. You need to think about your target audience. It can be a poster for everyone or for young people of your age. **ONE page** – not a number of PowerPoint slides. Save it. We could use it for a display when we get back to school. This is an important issue and we really need to get a **clear message across**. Words and pictures. Not massive fonts!

Some examples of what can be recycled:

- Batteries
- Bric-a-brac
- Cans
- Cardboard
- Carpet
- Cooking oil
- Electronic equipment
- Flat/plate glass
- Fluorescent tubes
- Fridges and Freezers
- Furniture (sofa, armchair, wardrobes)
- Gas bottles
- Glass bottles and jars

- Green garden waste
- Household and car batteries
- Household chemicals
- Large domestic appliances (cookers, ovens)
- Mattresses
- Newspapers, magazines, books and paper
- Paint
- Plaster and plasterboard\*
- Plastic bottles
- Printer cartridges
- Rubble and hardcore\*
- Scrap metal
- Textiles, clothes and shoes
- TV's and monitors
- Tyres
- Wood
