Computer Science

- Students are to log in to Showbie. Any student who has forgotten their log in should email <u>djo@allhallows.lancs.sch.uk</u> and their username and password will be given to them.
- Once logged in, students should click on 'join a class' and type the following code VGU82
- They should open the folder which says 'Work for school closure'.
- In this folder they will find 10 assignments. They should complete 1 assignment per week for the duration of the time that school is closed. All assignments will have a deadline which needs to be met. All assignments require students to read through a PowerPoint and complete some activity sheets. The activity sheets can be completed on Showbie using the text and pen tools, or they can be printed off and completed by hand. If an activity requires sketching, students can complete this on plain paper by hand and upload a photograph (using their phones) of the work to Showbie via the free Showbie app.
- Self assessment sheets will be uploaded so that students can correct their own work after each deadline. Students should write correct answers in purple when self assessing.
- Detailed instructions on how to complete each assignment have been given on Showbie by your class teacher. Teachers will be available to respond to queries or questions via Showbie each day. If you have a question about the work, leave a comment on the assignment and you will receive a reply from your Computing teacher.

Year 7, Year 8 and Year 9 Computing classes For Mr Carr's classes.

- Students are to log in to Google classroom using their school email. Any student who has forgotten their log in should email pca@allhallows.lancs.sch.uk and their username and password will be given to them.
- Once logged in, students should click on the 'Work for school closure' topic.
- In this topic they will find 10 assignments. They should complete 1 assignment per week for the duration of the time that school is closed. Each assignment has a deadline which must be met. All assignments require students to read through a PowerPoint and complete some activity sheets. The activity sheets can be completed on Google classroom.
- When complete, students MUST click the 'Turn in' button to submit their assignment.
- Self assessment sheets will be uploaded so that students can correct their own work after each deadline. Students should write correct answers in purple when self assessing.

Choose a particular type of hazard and explain the following:

- Causes of the hazard
- Where it occurs?
- Why it occurs?
- Effects of the hazard
- Responses to the hazard short term and long term responses.
- Are the responses different in rich / poor countries?

Use plenty of images and photographs and with information about the hazards. Make sure you write the project in your own words and do not simply copy and paste text from the internet. If you complete this task, research another hazard. The project can be hand written or completed on a computer.

Year 8 Non-governmental organisations

Create a project based piece of work about NGOs and their roles.

What is an NGO?

Give some examples of NGOs, explain what they do, why they are necessary and find their logos.

Choose 3 NGOs and research the following:

- Their origins and why/ where they were founded
- The role of the organisation
- Some particular schemes that have benefitted groups of people in LICs or NEEs.
- What job roles are available in NGOs.
- Would you like to work for an NGO explain the reasons why and the type of role you would like to undertake.

Use plenty of images and photographs and with information about the organisations. Make sure you write the project in your own words and do not simply copy and paste text from the internet.

The project can be hand written or completed on a computer.

Geography

Year 9 Geography of the Coronavirus

Create a project about the geography of the coronavirus.

Use plenty of images, photographs and graphs combined with information about the outbreak.

Make sure you write the project in your own words and do not simply copy and paste text from the internet.

The project can be hand written or completed on a computer.

Some ideas for different sections:

- What is a coronavirus?
- Research facts about the SARS outbreak (Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome) in 2002 and 2004.
- Where and when did the current outbreak begin?
- How is the virus spread?
- How can we contain the virus?
- How can it be treated?
- Find some maps to show the spread of the outbreak?
- What is a pandemic?
- What is the WHO and what is their role?
- Is there a vaccine?
- What other pandemics have occurred in the past research them and write about them in as much detail as possible.
