Further to my letter of Friday 15th May, I am writing to provide you with details of the school's opening times over the half term break and in the early part of June.

The school has been open to the children of key workers from the start of lock down. I would like to thank both the pupils who have attended, for the way in which they have conducted themselves in a safe and secure manner at all times, and my colleagues who have managed the systems put in place in a professional and thorough way. As the parents of pupils who have been attending regularly are able to provide childcare during the half term break the school will be **closed** for a week from Monday 25th May.
