

"When Pentecost day came round, they had all met in one room, when suddenly they heard what sounded like a powerful wind from heaven, the noise of which filled the entire house in which they were sitting; and something appeared to them that seemed like tongues of fire; these separated and came to rest on the head of each of them. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak foreign languages as the Spirit gave them the gift of speech.

Before Jesus ascended into heaven He promised the disciples that He would send an advocate, someone to guide and enable them to live godly lives.

Pentecost is when this took place, when the disciples received the Holy Spirit. It is celebrated on the Sunday 50 days after Easter and officially ends the Easter season. Pentecost is regarded as the birthday of the Church and the start of the Church's mission.
