WORD OF THE WEEK

MARK 6: 7-13

Jesus called the tweleve disciples together and sent them out in pairs. He gave them authority and power and ordered them, "Don't take anything with you on the trip except a walking stick- no bread, no beggar's bag, no money in your pockets. Wear sandals, but don't carry an extra shirt." He also told them, "Whenever you are welcomed, stay in the same house until you leave that place. If you come to a town where people do not welcome you or will not listen to you, leave it and shake the dust off your feet."

Then they were on the road. They preached with joyful urgency that life can be radically different; they brought wellness to the sick, anointed their bodies and healed them.

When you think of the word mission what comes to mind? How many examples of mission can you think of?

What does Jesus and the Church mean by mission? Mission comes from an ancient Latin word, *Mittere*, meaning to send.

Jesus sends his disciples into the world to share God's love with others. We are disciples too, and therefore we too are sent!

In this week's Word of the Week Jesus sent his disciples away to represent him in the world, just like when we are sent out into the community each evening and during the holidays as representatives of our school. Can you think of different ways in which you represent All Hallows, both in school and out of school?

Jesus sends the disciples on their way with two things- a stick and a friend. We are coming close to the end of the school year now, so let's take some time to think about what and who has been the supporting stick on our journey through this year and who has been our friend walking with us.

- Who have you helped/supported this year?
- Who has been a friend for you this year?
- How have you been a friend to others this year?


