PTFA AGM

Pupils should be aware that members of the public have called school concerned about the unsafe way some pupils are leaving the site at the end of the day. Some pupils, who come on their bike are not looking carefully before exiting Crabtree Avenue. Additionally, some pupils are looking down at their phones and not the passing traffic when crossing the roads close to school.
