Medicines in School

Please could parents and carers ensure that any medication a pupil brings into school is safely stored with the school office and the correct medical form filled out (this can be obtained from Reception) Pupils who need to access medication can then do so safely, as part of a planned intervention agreed by parents and carers.

Mobile Phone Use

Please reinforce the school's expectations around the use of mobile phones in school. In particular, pupils should report illness in school to a member of staff and should not text directly to parents. It is much more efficient and less worrying for parents if adults within the school make contact when a pupil is in any kind of distress. Additionally, pupils are in breach of the school's policy if they text or call directly from school and will consequently be sanctioned.

School Uniform

Following last week's newsletter, a further reminder that we have now reduced the number of measure to combat the spread of Covid-19. In that respect, pupils should now attend in full school uniform as they are able to access the PE changing rooms for their PE lesson. Please can you ensure that your child has the correct uniform for this part of the academic year, including a school blazer which should be worn within the school building.

School Events

I would like to take the opportunity to thank the many colleagues who contributed to our virtual Certificate Evening which went live last night. Covid-19 measures resulted in the school being unable to host the event on site, but the online alternative was great and well-received by pupils and parents.

The number of positive Covid-19 cases has dropped since we returned after the half term break, so we are able to look forward to delivering the majority of events published in the school calendar. However, we are disappointed to announce that our Senior Citizens Party has been cancelled. We look forward to hosting it once again next Christmas.

<u>TikTok</u>

I am sure that parents and carers are aware of the recent coverage in the media of concerns about the negative effects of the social media platform TikTok in school settings. A number of 'crazes' have appeared in the last few weeks which have led to school employees having

their data and image rights violated by pupils, who have uploaded content to the TikTok site. We have spoken to pupils in assemblies this week about the potentially catastrophic consequences of becoming involved in such activities. Information I have received from other local schools is that a number of recent incidents have led to the permanent exclusion of a number of pupils. I urge parents to engage in an ongoing discussion about the dangers of social media.
