Early Closure

A reminder that school will close next Friday at 1.30pm following the Achievement Assemblies in the morning. Lunch will be served for all pupils, followed by a short registration and buses will be available for the 1.30pm departure.

Covid-19 Restrictions

Thankfully, since our return to school after the half term break, the level of positive cases in school has drastically reduced. In light of this, from Monday 15th November, we are able to reduce the number of restrictions we imposed shortly before the half term break. Please note the following changes:

- Assemblies will once again be delivered to year groups in the arts theatre
- Pupils will be expected to come to school in full school uniform (please see item below)as the changing rooms will again be in use for PE
- Masks wearing will become optional. Pupils who remain anxious in crowded spaces must feel confident to wear a mask if they chose to do so.

We will of course continue with our regime of sanitising surfaces and ventilation of rooms will remain a key measures to combat the spread of the virus.

Winter Uniform

As I have stated on previous occasions, we are extremely proud of the way in which the vast majority of our pupils wear their school uniform. However, we have a number of concerns about the standard of school uniform at present and would like to emphasise the following

- At this point in the school year, blazers are compulsory. Pupils must have a blazer
 which should be worn at all times. Wearing a coat instead of a blazer as pupils travel
 around corridors is not permitted.
- Girls should now be wearing black tights, not white socks.
- Skirts must be worn to length as prescribed in our uniform policy (on or just above the knee). Skirts must not be rolled up at the top and pupils who have bought skirts deliberately in a smaller size to make them shorter in length must purchase a skirt to comply with the school policy.

As we are able to relax our Covid-19 restrictions from Monday, all form teachers will be carrying out a uniform check at registration on Monday to enable us to re-establish our customary high standards of dress.
