Covid-19 Update

I would like to give prior notice that our return to school following the Christmas break will, once again, be staggered for pupils. This measure will allow us to test pupils for Covid-19 on return to school. We received guidance from the Department for Education which strongly encourages schools to reintroduce on-site testing to allow the detection of positive cases which may have arisen from mixing socially during the Christmas break. During the staggered period, all classes will have online learning provision which will be delivered by teachers in school on the Teams platform. We will send a schedule for testing via ParentMail early next week. Pupils will also be bring home additional home testing kits next week. The DfE are continuing to recommend that pupils and staff undertake twice weekly testing.

Synergy System

Increasingly we are making better use of the school system Synergy to disseminate information and to communicate with parents and carers. All parents and carers have been sent a link from Mr Finch which allows them to access the system, however, we have noted that a sizeable number of parents have not yet accessed the system.

Importantly, in recent weeks, the school has issued Pupil Reports on Synergy and we remain concerned that without logging on those key documents may remain unread. Please contact school if you require the link to be sent to you again to enable you to sign in to Synergy.

School Uniform

We are increasingly concerned that following a number of reminders in our regular newsletters, we still have a small minority of pupils who are not adhering to the school's uniform requirements. I would be most grateful if parents could ensure that their child has a school blazer and that skirts are bought which are of the correct length as described in the Uniform Policy
