### Stem Month

March sees the start of STEM Month where we have a whole host of exciting STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) based activities taking place. It was kicked off on Wednesday with 8 Year 7 pupils attending an Engineering Fairytales session at PGHS, where they were able to complete engineering challenges (like creating a 30 minute timer for Cinderella from plastic cups, foil, paper plates, balloons etc) and then plan how they could deliver them to primary aged pupils.

Pupils in school will be receiving STEM based activities during form time and some will also be able to take part in competitions such as VEX IQ Robotics competition (Year 9), Lego Robotics Competition (Year 7), CanSat competition (Year 10), Faraday Challenge (Year 8). Year 9 girls will be attending a Women in Engineering morning where they are very fortunate to attend a fantastic workshop delivered by Lantei. Year 8 will also have the chance to take part in either a 3D printing workshop or an Engineering Humans Workshop at the end of the month.

We also have 2 fantastic STEM Ambassadors from BAE Systems supporting us in STEM Club throughout the month and beyond.
