Uniform Concern

Earlier this week, Mrs Washington, began to issue warning letters to pupils who continue to wear the skirts at a length which contravenes the school uniform policy. I have written to parents and carers previously about our concerns regarding skirt lengths, however a number of pupils are now gaining sanctions for not following the rule. As we near the end of this academic year, I am sure that families are beginning to plan the purchase of new items of uniform for the autumn ter. Please ensure that your child orders the correct size for the new academic year. We have reports from our stockists that pupils are sometimes deliberately ordering a smaller size to ensure that the length is also shorter. Uniform checks will be carried out in September and pupils without the correct skirt length will be asked to purchase a replacement. I believe that this is an issue that school and home must work together to solve. I commute quite a distance to school each day and I pass pupils from many schools queueing at bus stops for their school bus. Our uniform standards compare extremely favourable with all of those schools. The vast majority of our pupils wear their uniforms with pride and solving the concern over skirts will cement our positive standing in the community.
