Job Title:	Catering Assistant 1

Job Purpose

To provide catering support in the preparation, cooking and serving of food and beverages plus related catering duties.

Main Duties & Responsibilities

- To prepare the dining area for service, which may include moving and/or setting up furniture, setting up of trolleys and the cleaning and dismantling of these as required after service.
- To prepare the service area, hot cupboards and other equipment at the point of service for the efficient and effective service of meals
- To assist in the preparation, cooking and serving of food and beverages as directed by the Catering Manager
- To serve food according to the style and type of operation defined by the school
- To wash dishes, cutlery, tumblers, jugs, serving utensils, containers, tables and all other catering equipment in the catering environment.
- To clean on a daily basis all catering areas to a standard required by the school

- To undertake on and off the job training sessions as required by the Catering Manager
- To inform the Catering Manager of any defects in equipment or premises not meeting Health and Safety and/or Food Hygiene Regulation Standards.
- To undertake such other related duties as are required to ensure the dining area and kitchen are in a clean and hygienic condition and that the food service is effective and efficient.
- To undertake duties that may be required for the effective operation of the catering department including till duty (cashless catering) as directed by the Catering Manager
