'Le temps des loisirs' from the theme Identity and culture. Students will use the correct verbs, tenses and grammar to describe hobbies and leisure interests. They will revisit sports vocabulary and discuss internet technology. They will also talk about what they like to read, what sort of music they listen to and what they like to watch on TV and at the cinema.	'Jours ordinaires, jours de fête' from the theme Identity and culture. Students will use a range of verbs, tenses and complex grammar to describe ordinary days and special days. They will describe their daily lives, they will shop for food and clothes and they will talk about birthdays and other special events. Their knowledge of tenses will continue to grow.	'De la ville à la campagne' from the theme Local area, holiday and travel. Students will describe where they live using a range of tenses and complex structures. They will describe the pros and cons of our local area, they will revisit weather vocabulary and they will find out tourist information. They will ask questions, use the negative form and produce longer sentences using connectives and opinions.	'Le grand large...' from the theme Local area, holiday and travel. Students will use three tenses to describe holidays, from past experiences to a dream holiday. They will use transactional vocabulary to describe a hotel stay and when ordering at a restaurant. They will also describe nightmare holiday experiences. Students will take part in role plays and describe picture cards as part of this theme.

'Au collège' from the theme School. Students will describe their favourite subjects, their school routine, school trips and future plans using a range of different tenses and a variety of grammatical structures. They will discuss school rules, successes at school and the differences between a school here and one in France. They will access exam materials in the four skills.	'Bon travail!' from the theme Future aspirations, study and work. Students will focus on all aspects of work – a part time job, future career plans, their strengths and work experience. They will also learn about the importance and benefits of learning a language. They will continue to use a variety of tenses and complex grammatical structures.	'Un œil sur le monde' from the theme International and global dimension. Students will describe the dangers facing our world and how best we can protect our planet. They will also learn about volunteering and will be able to describe global and more local events. They will be able to state their opinions with reasons and will be confident with tenses and key grammatical terms.	Time to revise! Students will look back over the course and make preparations for the final examinations in the four skill areas: listening, speaking (role play, picture card and conversation), reading and writing. Their teachers will be on hand to help with their revision during the school day and after school. Online resources will also prove helpful ahead of the final examinations. On a fini – bonne chance!
