


PRAYER FOR THE WEEK

WORD OF THE WEEK

MATTHEW 28: 16-20

Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshipped him; but some doubted. Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

The Feast of the Ascension

On Thursday (18th May) we celebrate the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord. This is when Jesus was taken to heaven on the fortieth day after His resurrection. Just before His Ascension into heaven Jesus spoke the words of our Word of the Week to his disciples. These words were not just meant for the first disciples but for us too! How can you live out, put into action, this week's Word of the Week?



DISCIPLE AND FRIEND

The word 'disciple' comes from a Latin word,
'discere', which means 'to learn'.
